Topics: Atopic dermatitis diagnosis, Atopic dermatitis treatment, Warts, Diaper dermatitis, Herpes simplex, Pediculosis capitis, Urticaria, Hemangioma, Transient benign dermatoses of the first month: toxic erythema, acne, seborrheic dermatitis, milia, sterile pustules.

Alopecia areata, Pyoderma, Psoriasis, Acne.

When using antibiotics, antimycotics, antiviral drugs in Pediatric Dermatology.

Topical treatment: packs, creams, ointments, emollients, sunscreens.

Genodermatoses: ichthyosis, neurofibromatosis, epidermolysis bullosa, tuberous sclerosis, xeroderma pigmentosum.

Nevi: acquired and congenital nevocellular nevi, Spitz nevus, halo nevus, blue nevus, dermal melanocytosis, aplasia cutis, epidermal nevus, sebaceous nevus, hyperpigmented nevus, hypopigmented nevus.

Viral infections: hand, foot and mouth, milker's nodules, Gianotti-Crosti papular acrodermatitis, pityriasis rosea, pityriasis lichenoides, atypical exanthemata.

Bacterial infections: Lyell necrolysis, erysipela, neonatal hidradenitis, scrofuloderma.

Micotic infections: tinea corporis, tinea capitis, chronic muco-cutaneous candidiasis.

Parasitoses: leishmaniasis, phthiriasis, tick bite, animal acariasis.

Exogenous dermatosis: photodermatitis, miliaria, fixed drug eruption, toxic erythema of the newborn.

Bullous dermatosis: dermatitis herpetiformis, pemphigoides, chronic bullous dermatosis of childhood, pemphigus.

Vasculitis: erythema nodosum, Schönlein-Henoch purpura, erythema multiforme, aphthosis.

Miscellanea: lichen ruber planus, lichen striatus, lichen nitidus, vitiligo, acrodermatitis.

Dermatitis artefacta: trichotillomania, acne excoriata, tics, battered child syndrome.

Connective tissue diseases: lupus erythematosus, scleroderma, dermatomyositis.

Tumors: calcifying epithelioma, telangiectatic granuloma, juvenile xanthogranuloma, mastocytosis, Langerhans cell histiocytosis.
